Ardennes Adventure 2023

26th May – 4th June 2023

The Ardennes Adventure is a 9 day fun filled trip to Belgium where participants get to experience climbing, canoeing, caving and mountain biking. It really is an action packed, fun filled trip that is open to all Explorers and Older Scouts (13+) in West Lancs.

Never been on a Scout international trip before? Or want to take your skills to the next level? Then this is the trip for you!

We camp at the Belgium Scouting Centre "Le Refuge" that is situated in Mont-Godinne in the Ardennes Region of Belgium. Catering for yourselves you get to decide what you eat, buy your own food and cook it just how you like it!!

You get to choose 3 activities out of Canoeing, Climbing, Caving and Mountain Biking. Spending 2 days on each of the activities you get to really test your skills, learn new ones and probably do something you have never done before. Mid-week we have a day off the adventurous stuff and do a cultural day, what this involves is decided by the group.

Getting there is via minibus setting off on the Friday evening and returning the following Sunday, this way we can make the most of our time out there.

The cost of the adventure is £495, however sign up prior to 1st January 2023 this is reduced to £470 as an early bird offer. The price includes all transport, activities, accommodation, breakfasts, specialist activity equipment, an event polo shirt, international necker and the training weekend. (Lunches, teas and snacks are not included).

Julian Alps, 22nd July – 5th August 2023



The Plan!

We will be heading over to the Julian Alps, in the northern part of Slovenia, where we will be having an action packed two weeks of various mountain activities, including but not limited to:

- •Via ferrata Moving over steep terrain in the mountains using pre fixed cables and ladders to allow fast and efficient moving.
- •Rock climbing This will include different aspects and grades of climbing. In lots of various locations including the valley floor and within the mountains.
- •Walking There will be all levels and lengths of walks available suitable for mixed abilities, in a stunning mountainous environment.
- •Mountaineering We will be heading up to some high summits and moving over steep and scrambling terrain, maybe even summiting Triglav (2864m) the highest mountain in Slovenia.
- •Mountain biking Using many of the local trails, we will be offering this activity for people to ride some amazing trails in a beautiful place.
- •Overnight mountain hut stays Using one of the methods above to gain access to one of the high mountain huts and staying overnight. This is fantastic experience without the discomfort of camping remotely.

We will be also doing some pre trip training weekends, this will allow us all to get to know each other before heading out as well as working on and developing our skills and fitness required in the mountains. This will cover map reading, rope work, mountain safety and camp skills.

Accommodation & Transport

To allow maximum time out in the alps, we will be flying out and getting transfers to Kranjska Gora, where we will be camping for the two weeks. Due to us flying out everyone will need to cook for themselves or possibly in small groups. This will also allow us to have any equipment required for overnight stays and bivvies.

Skill/ Fitness level

The trip is open to explorer scouts, Network and adult volunteers who have an interest in the mountains and what they have to offer, as well as a good baseline fitness. This is to allow everyone to enjoy the trip and get the most out of it.

Cost

This trip costs £1597 for 2 weeks which includes all your transport in the UK and in-country, food, insurance and 2 training weekends in the UK.

We're heading back to the Cairngorms in February 2023 for Snow and Ice.
This is a Winter Mountaineering Experience for Explorers, Network and
Leaders.

From 10-15 Feb 2023 you'll have the opportunity to take part in Winter Mountaineering whether that be expeditions, Winter Climbing, Winter Hill Ascents, Snowholes, Skiing and much more.

Cost is £325 which includes all your accommodation, transport to and from Scotland and on the event, fully catered, equipment and instruction from qualified winter instructors. No winter experience is needed and we can lend winter kit for no extra fee.

You do need to be 15 years old upwards and have had some experience of walking – whilst you don't need winter experience, this isn't a trip for complete novices who haven't been walking in the mountains before. 


